

About Us

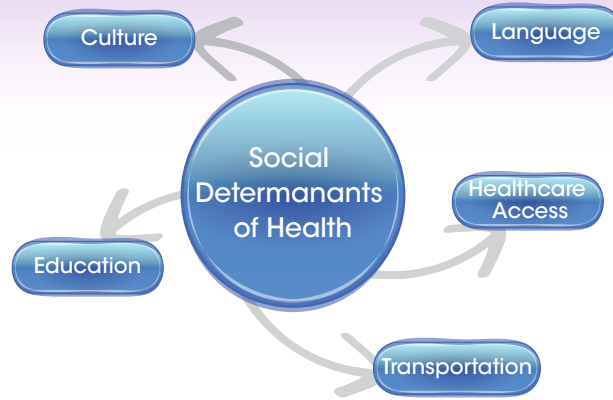

Who Do We Serve?

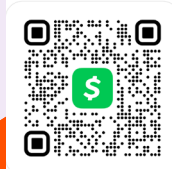
